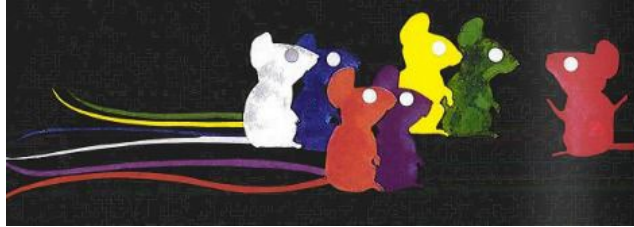

One day, seven blind mice were surprised to find a strange Something by their pond. "What is it?" they cried, and they all ran home.



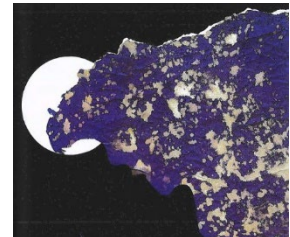
On Monday, Red Mouse went first to find out.
