Patrick Joseph Bumatay Filipino American United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit (Federal)	<i>Edmo v. Idaho</i> (2018) This case was about Adree Edmo being denied gender confirmation surgery when he was incarcerated at the Idaho Department of Correction.
Denny Chin Chinese American United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit (Federal)	United States v. Madoff (2009) Bernard ("Bernie") Madoff's company created false trading reports; the estimated amount from Madoff's scheme is \$65 billion.
Jennifer Choe-Groves Asian American United States Court of International Trade (Federal)	Primesource Building Products, Inc. v. United States (2020) A US importer of steel derivative products argued that former President Trump's proclamation to expand tariffs under Section 232 of the Trade Expansion Act of 1962 was unlawful and unconstitutional.

James C. Ho Taiwanese American United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit (Federal)	Texas League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC) v. Hughs (2020) The Texas LULAC challenged whether the Texas governor's order to limit absentee ballot dropboxes to one per county violated the 14 th Amendment.
Anthony W. Ishii Asian American United States District Court for the Eastern District of California (Federal)	Silvester v. Becerra (2018) California's ten-day waiting period for firearm purchasers was challenged.
Ronald S.W. Lew Chinese American United States District Court for the Central District of California (Federal)	Agudath Israel of America v. Andrew M. Cuomo (2020) Agudath Israel argued that NY Governor Cuomo's singling out of Jewish synagogues during the COVID-19 pandemic was unconstitutional.

Goodwin Liu Taiwanese American Associate Justice of the California Supreme Court (State)	United Teachers-LA v. Los Angeles Unified School District (1994) United Teachers-LA petitioned to grant part-time status to eligible employees, allowing them to receive benefits and shorten their work hours.
Kiyo A. Matsumoto Japanese American (Nisei) United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York (Federal)	Martin Shkreli v. United States (2019) Letitia James filed a suit against Martin Shkreli that would permanently ban him from working in the pharmaceutical industry.
Amit Priyavadan Mehta Indian American United States District Court for the District of Columbia (Federal)	<i>Trump v. Mazars USA, LLP</i> (2019) This court case involves subpoenas made by the US House of Representatives to obtain the tax returns of former President Donald Trump.

Susan Oki Mollway Japanese American United States District Court for the District of Hawaii (Federal)	Atay v. County of Maui (2016) A Maui County ordinance was challenged regarding the ban of cultivation and testing of genetically engineered (GE) plants.
Nicholas J. Ranjan Asian American United States District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania (Federal)	Donald J. Trump for President, Inc. v. Boockvar (2020) Accommodations made by Pennsylvania elections for the COVID-19 pandemic were questioned whether they violated state election law and the US Constitution.
Amul Roger Thapar South Asian American United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit (Federal)	United States v. Walli (2012) Three activists trespassed and vandalized a government building that stores uranium, causing about \$8,000 worth of damages.
