She was born in Vietnam and immigrated to the United States at age ten. Her family opened a doughnut shop in North Hollywood, where she worked during high school and college. Nguyen has many firsts: first Vietnamese American federal judge, first Asian Pacific Islander American woman federal judge in California, and first Asian American woman to serve as a federal appellate judge.
