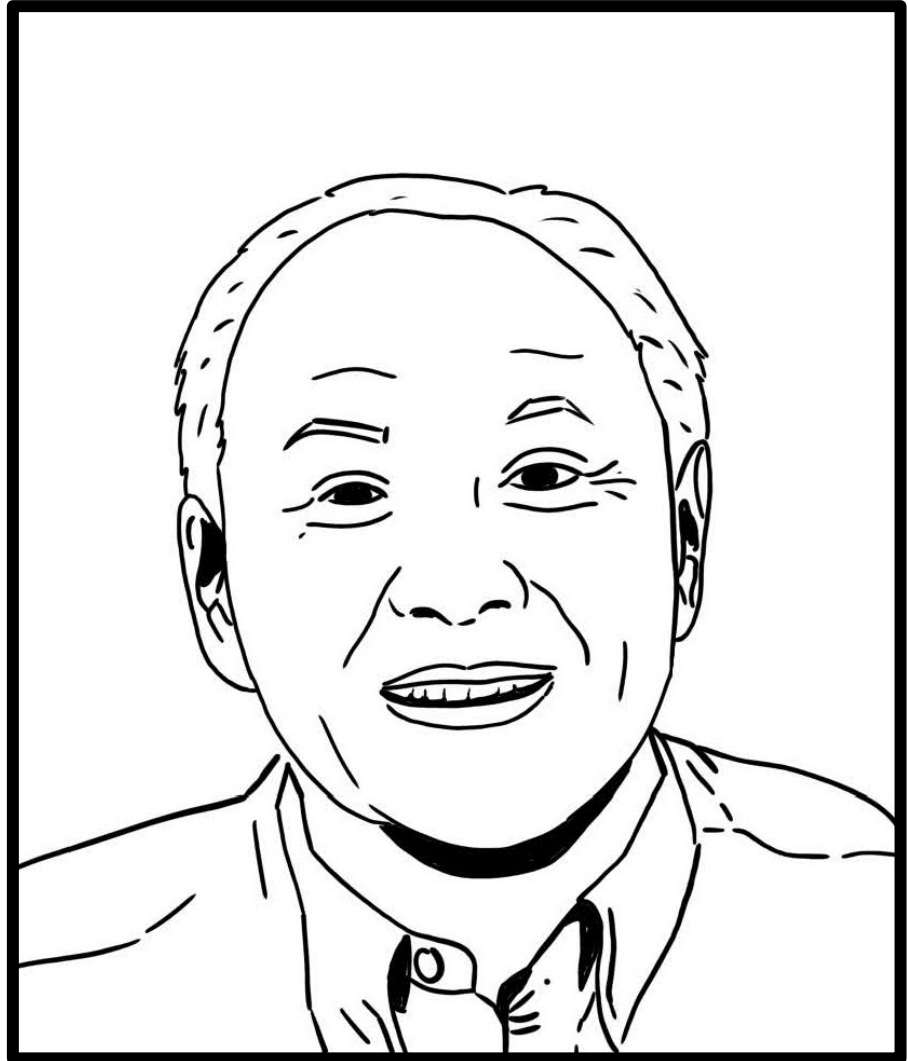
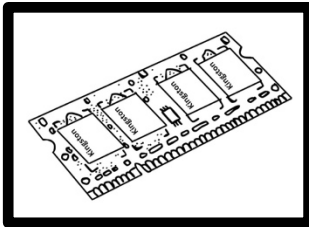

David immigrated to the United States with his wife to seek a better education. He eventually earned an electrical engineering degree. After losing most of his savings in the 1987 stock market crash, David joined John Tu and invented a cutting-edge memory module in a garage. A memory module is an important component of a computer that stores data temporarily. The two men founded Kingston Technology in 1987, which has grown into a multi-billion-dollar business. They received the Business People of the Year Award in 2020 from the *Orange County Business Journal*. David and wife Diana established the Sun Family Foundation in 1999 to give underprivileged children access to education.
