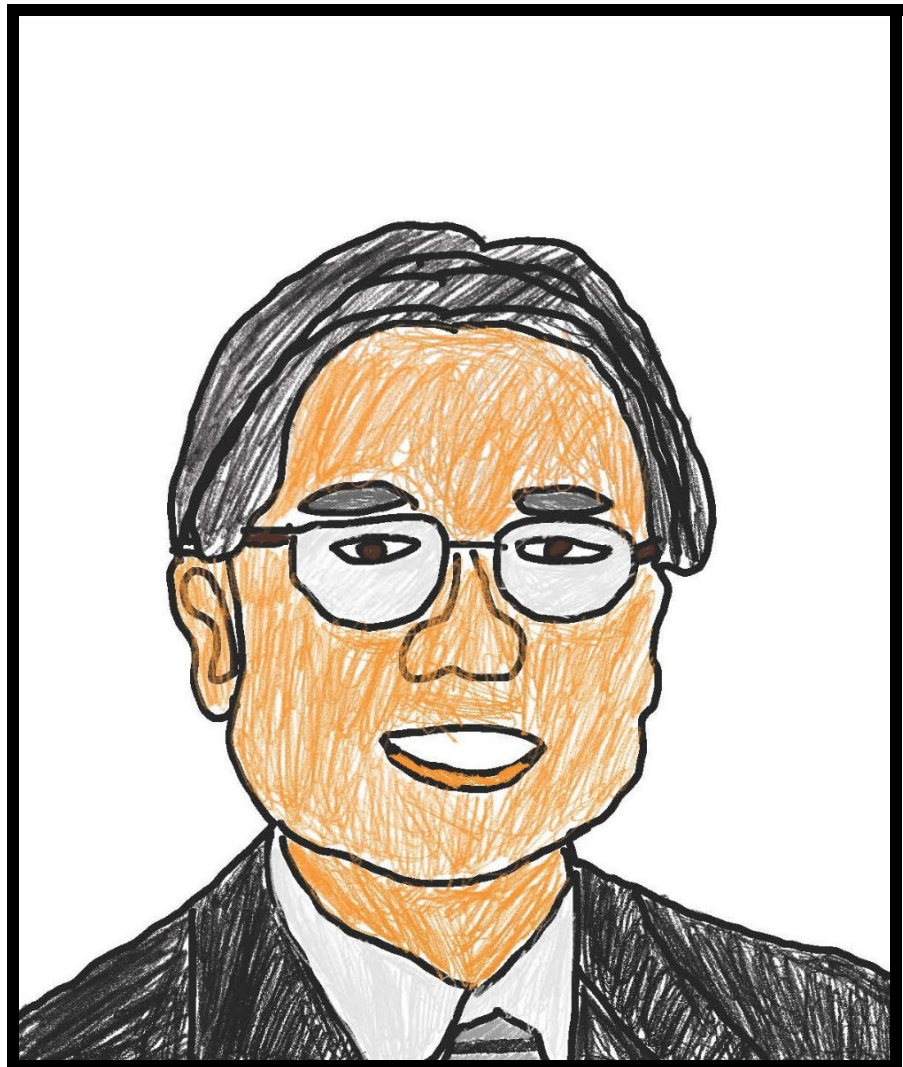
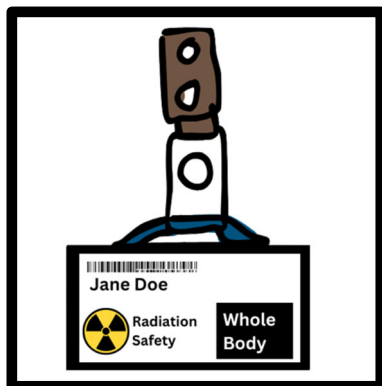

Tuan grew up in Vietnam, where his parents placed a high value on education, especially science. During boyhood, Tuan made and invented his own toys. At age seventeen, he moved to Switzerland and earned a PhD in Biophysical Chemistry. He later immigrated to the United States. In 1987, Tuan's first invention was a wearable chemical dosimeter badge that detects exposure to toxic chemicals. Tuan can speak five languages: Vietnamese, English, French, German, and Spanish. He holds over thirty patents for his inventions and has received numerous awards for them.
