



### **Tiffany Young**

Tiffany was born in San Francisco and grew up in Diamond Bar, California. She lost her mother when she was twelve years old. Her family consists of her father, an older sister, and an older brother. Tiffany began singing when she was a high school sophomore. She was rejected in a Los Angeles singing contest because she did not meet the age requirement of sixteen (she was fifteen). But a South Korean entertainment agency discovered her, and she left for South Korea in 2004. Her biggest obstacle at the time was learning the Korean language. Tiffany eventually debuted in 2007 as a member of the popular Korean girl band, SNSD or Girls' Generation. In 2012, a subgroup named TTS was formed with Tiffany. Tiffany made her solo debut in 2016 with her album *I Just Wanna Dance*. It was chosen by *Billboard* as the seventh best K-pop album of 2016. Tiffany returned to Los Angeles to study acting. In 2018, she released singles like "Remember Me," the theme song for the film *Coco*. Tiffany is attributed as the first female K-pop artist to walk the red carpet of the American Music Awards in 2018.
